In addition to Anića kuk, climbers can enjoy climbing on different rocks such as Debeli kuk, Veliki Ćuk, Skradelina and Kukovi ispod Vlake.

The Modrič and Manita Peć Caves

This cave, located only 29 meters above sea level, is waiting for you to explore it.

About 800 meters long, the Modrič Cave offers you a journey through its own collection of natural sculptures. Walking through the interior of the cave gives you a unique opportunity to explore diverse landscapes. The cave will take you through labyrinths of narrow gaps and spacious halls, where every corner will reveal new shapes and magic.

Just one step into this underground realm reveals incredible cave decorations created by the skillful hands of nature. Here, in the Manita Peć Cave, every stone and every drop of water contribute to the story of natural evolution, creating a surprising world of shapes and plays of light. The stalactites and stalagmites formed in this way will enrich your imagination, which will blossom as you discover the incredible forms created by long-term processes.

Guided Hiking Tour of Paklenica

Pack your backpacks and get ready for adventure, because we're going on a guided hiking tour of the Paklenica National Park! If you have ever wanted to feel the true power of nature and become part of something majestic, this is the right adventure for you. These natural beauties are what makes active holidays possible, offering visitors the opportunity to explore untouched nature, impressive landscapes and enchanting flora and fauna.

Your adventure begins at Veliko Rujno, an impressive plateau at 900 meters above sea level. We pass through picturesque mountain landscapes that depict the richness and diversity of the region. After descending to Ramića dvori, the path takes us all the way to Velika Paklenica canyon. On this hike, we cover a little over 11 kilometers during a moderately demanding 7-hour ascent. Our trail passes through enchanting landscapes, sunny plateaus, while forest areas provide pleasant shade along the way.

A simple hike through the gorge of Velika Paklenica takes us to the very heart of Paklenica. Feel the adrenaline as you pass through this popular area with more than 400 climbing routes that attract enthusiasts all year round.

After relaxing in the rural ambience of Ramića dvori at 555 m above sea level and enjoying the view of the Paklenica landscape, a gentle descent brings us back to the parking lot at Velika Paklenica, where our tour ends. Don't worry about the equipment - we've got everything covered! A guide, a ticket to Paklenica National Park, and a packed lunch are included, and you need to bring suitable shoes and clothes, a small backpack, rain gear, sunscreen, walking sticks, enough food and water, first aid and an identity card.


Sunrise at the Top

The adventure in this magical area begins with a guided tour that leads from Paklenica to Sveto Brdo, one of the most significant peaks of Velebit. In that place, where the mountain and the sky become one, Sveto Brdo challenges the spirits of adventurers to feel the magic and beauty of the peak.

The two-day Velebit Ridge-Top Hike adventure begins early in the morning with a drive to the starting point, the Libinje plateau, which is located on the eastern edge of Paklenica at 780m above sea level. During the demanding guided tour from NP Paklenica towards Sveto Brdo, you will witness landscapes that will capture your attention and tell you their stories. At 1,751 m above sea level, there is an incredible 360° panoramic view of the Lika region, the islands located in the Adriatic Sea and the hinterland of Zadar.

We offer you the opportunity to enjoy nature and feel the adrenaline by exploring this undiscovered gem. The package includes a car transfer, guide, ticket to Paklenica National Park, dinner, packed lunch, overnight stay, breakfast, and all you need to bring is suitable shoes and clothes, backpack, walking sticks, enough food and water, flashlight, first aid, mobile phone and identity card. Don't forget your good mood!

The ascent under the full moon and starry sky is further enriched by a short rest at the top where you can wake up to a magnificent sunrise, experiencing nature in all its beauty and power. On this trip, every effort you make will be rewarded with unforgettable memories. This trip is one of the most demanding but also the most rewarding in the region, and after every step and ascent, you will be refreshed and rested.

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🧿 Mirila

Wirila are specific funeral memorials along Velebit's roads and trails. These symbols of life and death in the mountains were made between the 17th and 20th centuries, and are related to the funeral customs of the local population, who had to carry their deceased to the cemetery due to the distance from churches and cemeteries. Headstones and footstones, placed in the length of the deceased, are scenes that evoke difficult life and death in the mountains.

Today, at several marked locations within educational trails, visitors can walk through the past of this amazing region. These stone markers provide a unique insight into the times when people lived from and with Velebit, testifying to the way of life, customs and rituals as an intangible cultural treasure of Croatia.

Ethno house Marasović is the host of the exhibition "Mirila - the rested soul", which in the contemporary interpretation of scientists and artists revives these customs, the creation and dying of an entire time.

Don't miss a visit to the Bear trench, a place with a vertical depth of 100 meters, and numerous bone remains of a cave bear. There are also the Great Hall and the Hall of the Paleolithic Hunter, where traces of ancient hunting expeditions have been preserved.

The Lower Cave, with slightly longer canals of 4058 meters, will open the door to a completely different world for you. Here, every drop of water plays with the cave walls, creating fascinating stalactites and stalagmites, while stories of ancient cave bears unfold among the stone walls. Get ready to be amazed as you explore Bear Hall, Mammoth Hall and other impressive spaces.

Cerovac Caves are an essential tourist attraction, therefore organized tours with expert guides are available for both wonderful caves. What makes this adventure really special are the numerous photo breaks. Our experienced guides will show you where to best capture every moment - whether it's a wild horse running free, or one of the locations where Winnetou movies were filmed. Yes, you heard that right! Here you can walk in the footsteps of Winnetou, the legendary Indian hero of the Wild West, and feel the magic of the places where the story of the Apache tribe came to life.

In order to have an authentic experience, you will have the opportunity to drive all-terrain vehicles all the way to the foot of Tulove grede, known for its picturesque limestone rocks. The final point of our adventure is the canyon of the Zrmanja river, another film location that has left a mark in many hearts.

Don't worry if you are not an experienced hiker or photographer. Velebit Photo Safari is designed to be suitable for all ages and fitness levels. Indulge in the beauty of nature with ease, taking short walks and using every opportunity for the perfect photo. And with each break on the way, you will feel refreshed and learn about the rich history of this region, from herders who lived here for thousands of years, to interesting facts about Velebit. Dioin us on a three-hour guided bike tour day trip and experience Velebit, the longest mountain range in Croatia, which stretches along the Adriatic Sea from Vratnik above Senj in the northwest, to the river Zrmanja in the southeast in a length of 145 km.

Our journey begins near the church of St. Francis on the old macadam road Obrovac - Sveti Rok. The uphill ride takes us to the foot of Tulove grede, imposing rock formations and one of the most attractive and unrecognizable peaks of Velebit, where you can explore beautiful landscapes that have served as sceneries for many films, including those about Winnetou, the most famous fictional Indian chief.

The road then takes us downhill towards Veliko and Malo Libinje at 780 meters above sea level, and the ride continues on a macadam road in a length of 19 km, all the way to Starigrad. The trail is a combination of asphalt and macadam roads, and the total ride covers almost 34 kilometers. Optimal fitness and cycling experience are required and the ride is marked as demanding, with an effective ride time of 3 hours and a total duration of 5-6 hours.

During the ride, enjoy wonderful views of Sveto Brdo, the Adriatic Sea, the Zadar archipelago and the inland, and the Paklenica Riviera will delight you with its natural beauty. The package includes a mountain bike, a helmet, a guide, a ticket to the Velebit Nature Park and a meal.

Crnopac is the southernmost mountain of the Velebit mountain range, with the highest peak of the same name, which is 1402 m high. It is adorned by rugged and steep ridges, valleys and various reliefs. It offers one of the best views of Dalmatia and Lika, but also a rare opportunity to see the entire Velebit from one place. It is possible to approach the very top via marked hiking trails Prezid - Veliki Crnopac, and Prezid - Crnopac lodge - Veliki Crnopac. From now on you can also discover it with the newly opened via ferrata Bat that's recommended for experienced hikers.

he Vrana Lake Nature Park is a karst valley that stretches along the Adriatic coast and covers an area of approximately 57 km². It is located just a five-minute drive from the village of Pakoštane. It is considered to be an exceptional recreational area and habitat of global importance, and serves as a nesting site for more than 260 species of birds and as a resting place and feeding ground for countless migratory birds. You can enter the park at three official entrances, Crkvine, Kamenjak and Prosika port. The best way to get to the lake, regardless of the chosen entrance, is by car, pre-arranged transport or as part of a tour. A variety of leisure options are waiting for you there.



Ornithology

Vrana Lake Nature Park is an ornithological paradise, home to more than 260 species of birds whose local populations are of exceptional importance at the national, European and global level. Every morning and every sunset here is especially magical, with birds dancing in the sky and searching for food.

With the right guide and binoculars in hand, join the game of discovering and identifying the beautiful feathered inhabitants of this region. In this wonderful corner of the world, the sounds of birds become melodies that tell the stories of life in this protected paradise.

The best time to visit is spring and autumn, when you can go on a guided tour and become a true birdwatcher. 


Between Biograd and Pakoštane, discover the ideal trail for you whether you prefer riding along the coast or exploring the inland of the region. Each trail offers a different level of difficulty and length, allowing you to choose the one that best suits your fitness and preferences.

There are a total of more than 50 km of cycling trails around Vrana lake. A real cycling gem, and at the same time the longest route starts in the village of Vrana, near the local church, and climbs to Majdan, from where there is a view of the ornithological reserve. The trail continues along the eastern shore of the lake towards the Prosika info center. Part of the trail along the east coast passes along the Babin škoj peninsula, where you can discover the remains of the Liburnian fortress and the Venetian guardhouse. In the port of Prosika, refresh yourself in the shade and fill your water bottles, enjoying the view of the canal that connects the lake and the sea.

Passing the western shore of the lake, in the direction of Crkvine, you reach a 3 km stretch of the main coastal road (magistrala), after which you go back offroad and ride through the hinterland of Drage and Pakoštane. These routes offer you the opportunity for an active holiday, soaking up the sun and fresh air, with the possibility of exploring archaeological sites and enjoying the rich flora and fauna.

Embark on an adventure, feel the refreshing breeze on your face while cycling through different landscapes and discover unexplored corners of this wonderful part of Croatia. Challenging terrain, varied landscapes, and the smells and sounds of nature make this region a true paradise for all lovers of active tourism.
